

**Botanical Name:** *Dalea pulchra*

**Common Name:** Bush Dalea, Indigo Bush, Santa Catalina Prairie Clover



**Family:** Fabaceae

**Habitat:** Rocky hillsides and washes

**Native Distribution:** SE Arizona and Sonora, Mexico

**Elevation:** 2,500 to 5,000 ft

**Hardiness:** 15°F

**Type:** Evergreen

**Size:** 4' tall x 5' wide

**Shape:** Open, rounded

**Growth Rate:** Moderately fast

**Flowers:** ¾" clusters of reddish-purple blooms

**Bloom Season:** Winter to spring

**Fruit:** Tiny seeds

**Foliage:** ½" very fine, grayish-green compound leaves with fine hairs

**Exposure:** Full and reflected sun

**Shade:** Filtered

**Water Requirements:** Low

**In the Landscape:** Use as an informal border or hedge, and as an accent to larger plants. Little to no maintenance.

**Wildlife:** Attracts bees and butterflies.

**Other Stuff:**

- Can be susceptible to over-watering, so make sure it's planted in well-draining soil.
